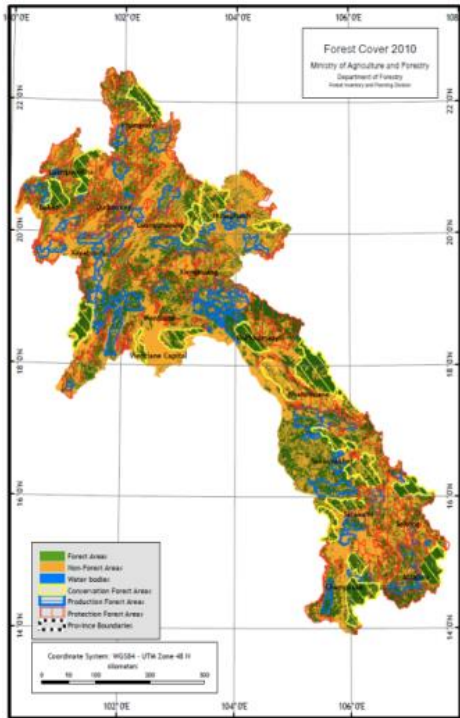
Sustainable Natural Resource Management Project



Drought in the southern Vietnam

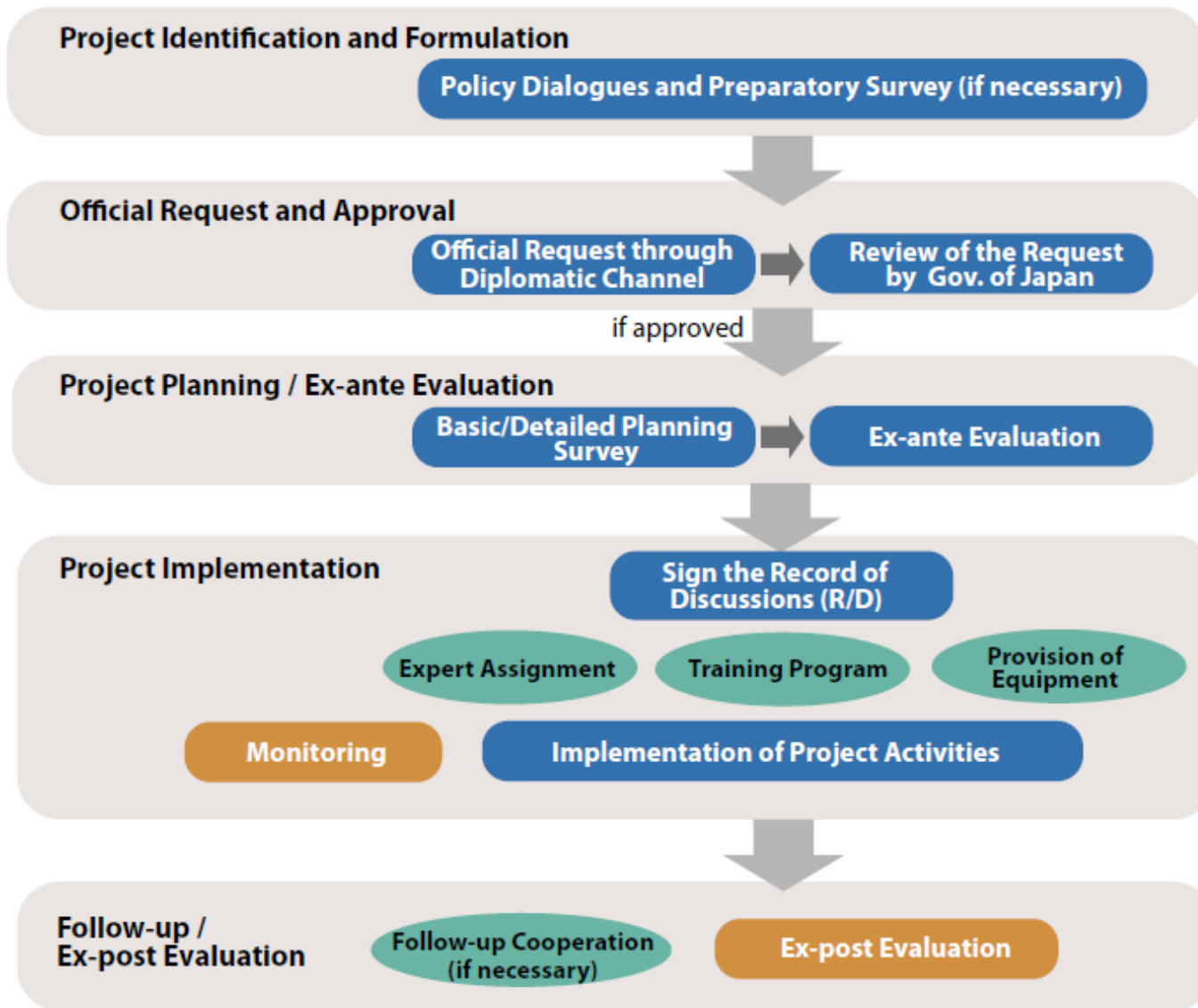
