GIZ profile

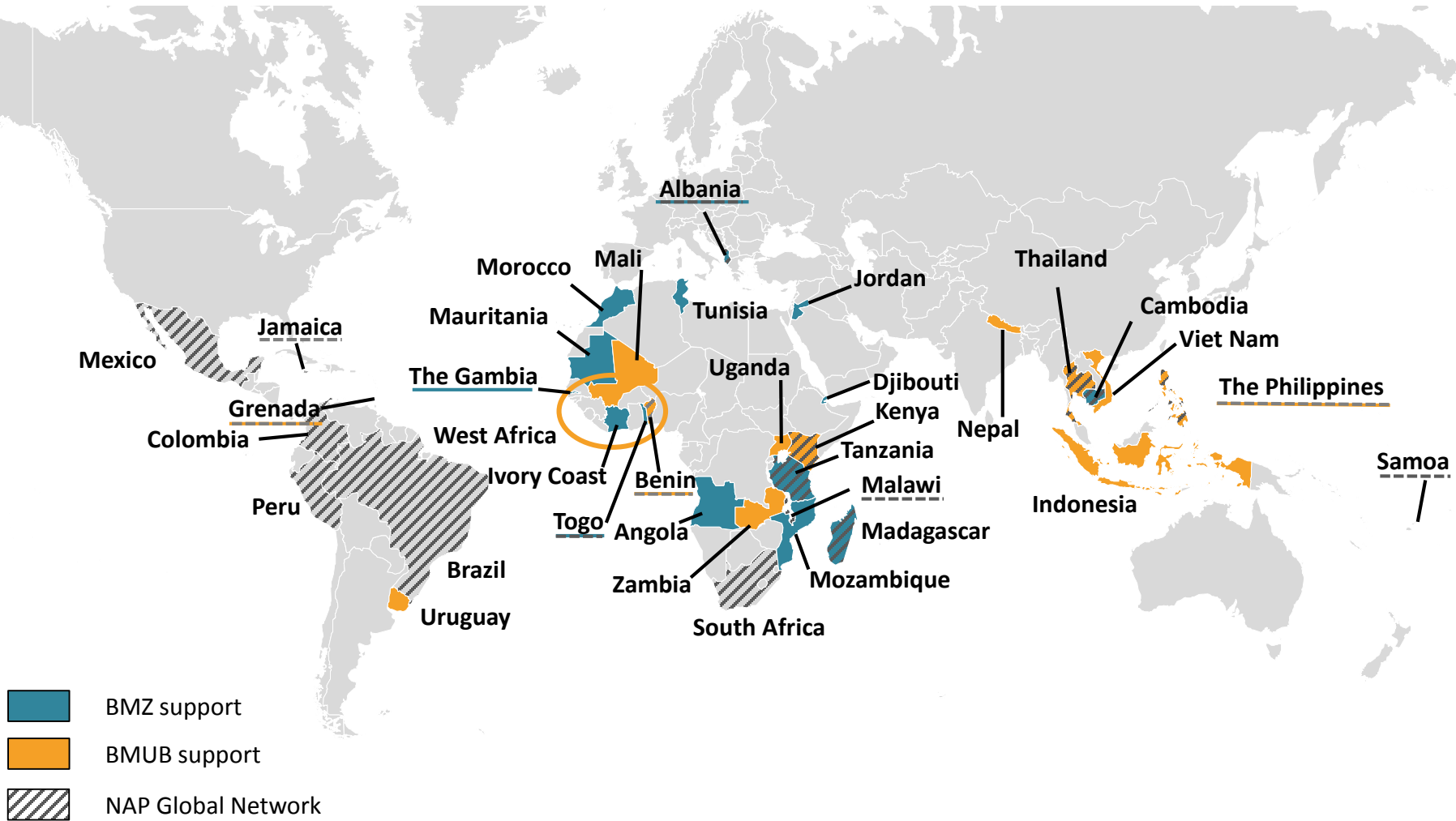
- Established on 1 January 2011, GIZ brings together under one roof the long-standing expertise of DED, GTZ and InWent.

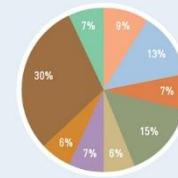
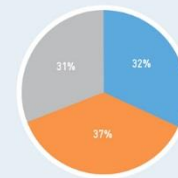
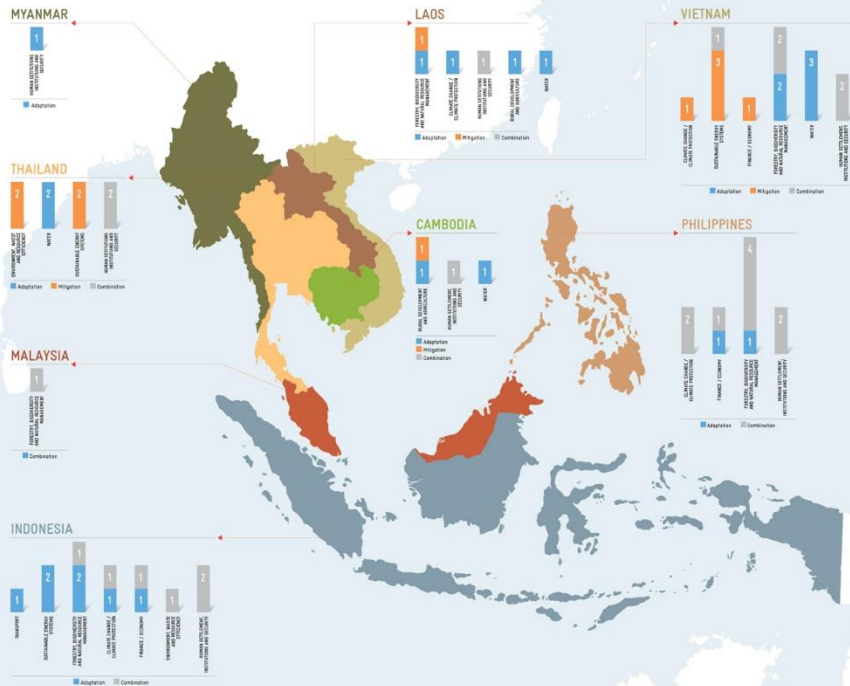

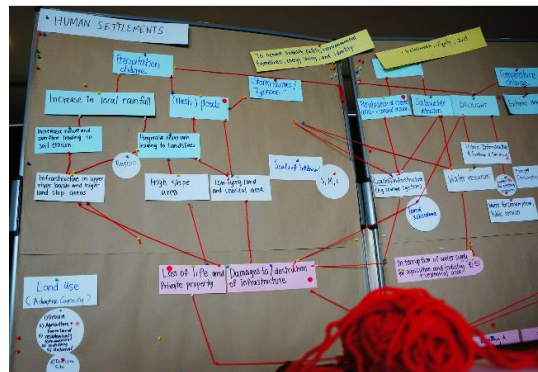

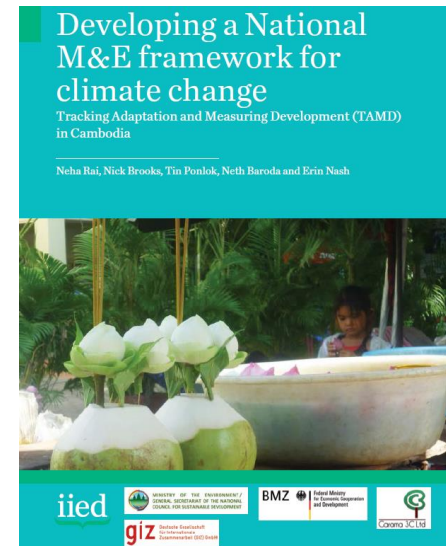

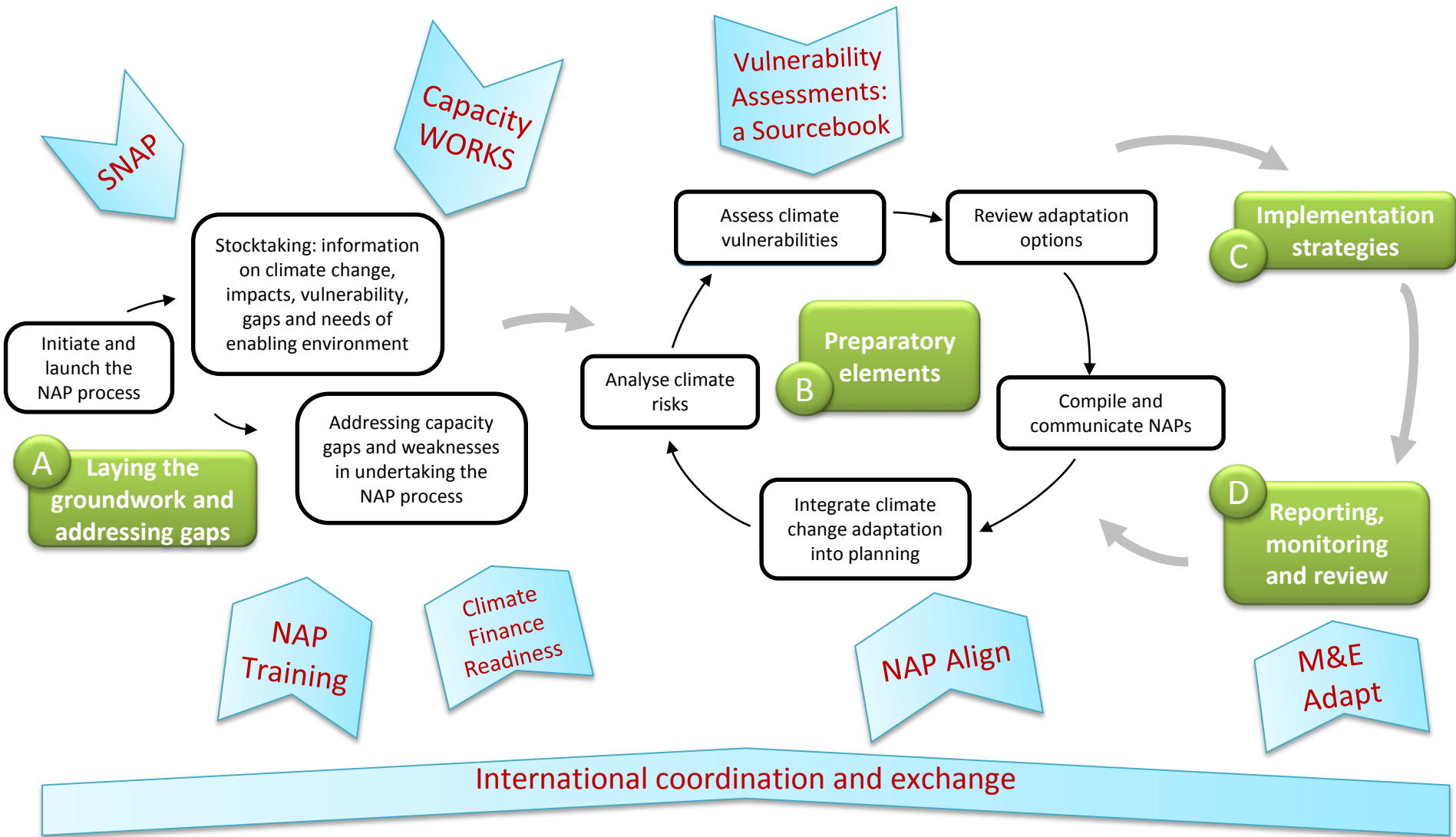

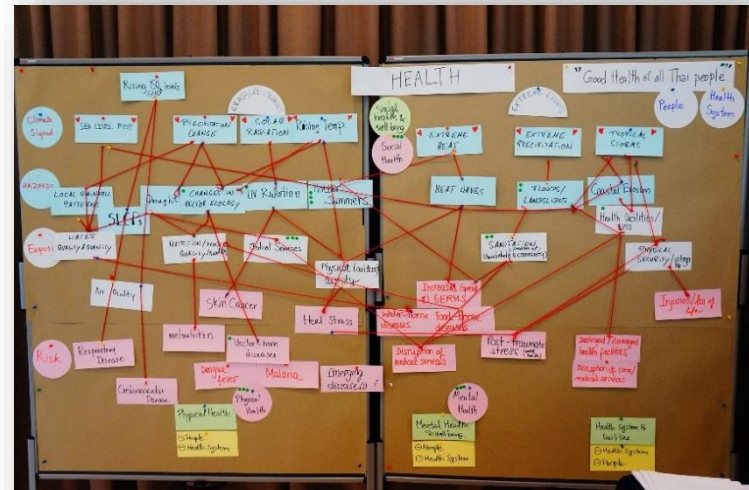
- Inter-ministerial **NAP training**
